For the Intentions of our Parishioners



Ash Wednesday is **March 5, 2025**, and marks the beginning of **Lent**: Masses for Ash Wednesday will be at 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. Distribution of Ashes will be given after each Mass.

Fridays during Lents, Mass will be at **8:00 a.m.**

Wednesdays during Lent, **Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament** will be from **3:00 p.m.—6:00 p.m.** Mass will remain at 6:00 p.m., followed by Station of the Cross.

### FAST & ABSTINENCE

In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence. For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. **However, for those 59 and older and in reasonable health, this discipline does not apply, but can reap from the Spiritual benefits from abstaining from meat.** When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal. Two smaller meals may also be taken, but not to equal a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards.
